Overview of LanLicenser 4.1

This document summarizes what is new in LanLicenser 4.1 and how it is deployed.

Introduction

ABC Enterprise Systems aim is to continually improve the performance, security, and stability of LanLicenser. As part of this effort, we develop updates, fixes, and other improvements that address issues reported by our customers and partners. To make it easier for customers to get these updates and enhancements, we have combined them into a single installation package, and make that package available for existing LanLicenser v4.0 SP2 and new customers.

LanLicenser 4.1 is available from the '*Support Center*' section on our website: <u>www.lanlicenser.com</u>. The download size is around 89 Megabytes (MB).

What's new in LanLicenser 4.1?

LanLicenser 4.1 includes new functionality, updates and hot fixes, including:

• Hardware Inventory

Keep a watchful eye on your hardware and precisely plan hardware upgrades. LanLicenser 4.1 incorporates a powerful hardware scanning component that gathers in-depth hardware information for all your Microsoft Windows Workstations and Servers. Not only does it gather CPU, memory, disk drive and many other hardware details, but also detects any hardware that has been changed or removed using our proprietary 'Change-Tracking Mechanism'.

• Full SQL Server 2008 Support

LanLicenser 4.1 fully integrates with Microsoft's latest industry standard database server. Both the LanLicenser main Site and Software Metering servers can now be installed to all versions of SQL Server 2008, including SQL Server 2008 Express Edition.

• Improved 64-bit Integration

As well as offering enhanced User Interface stability for Microsoft Windows 64-bit operating systems, LanLicenser 4.1 now monitors any and all 64-bit applications that are executed on your Client Workstations.

• Enhanced Inactivity Monitoring

Inactivity monitoring is now fully functional across multiple Windows sessions, improving on LanLicenser's already in-depth inactivity detection.

• Compatible and Certified for Windows 7

The LanLicenser 4.1 Client agent has passed all Microsoft-designed tests for compatibility and reliability on Windows 7.

• Enhanced Offline Restrictions

LanLicenser 4.1 now offers the ability to restrict applications from running if the Client is disconnected from the main site Server.

• Shortcut Hiding

Only show shortcuts for programs that are allowed to be run by the end user! LanLicenser 4.1 now offers functionality to hide ALL shortcuts (using our fully configurable user, group and computer restrictions) in order to improve the end user experience.

Updated Software Identification Database

LanLicenser's proprietary Software Identification database has now been updated to enhance the product registration experience.

• Improved Report Wizard and more Reports

Improvements to the Report Wizard have increased its speed and efficiency and there are now a number of new Reports.

• Increased Stability, Performance and Security

LanLicenser 4.1 now offers a more robust end user experience with numerous bug fixes and performance improvements. The MMC user interface has been tuned to increase stability and Database efficiency has also been improved.

Deploying LanLicenser 4.1

If you already have LanLicenser 4.0 with SP2 installed and wish to upgrade your installation then please go to page **5** of this guide.

Step 1: Once you have downloaded LanLicenser 4.1, copy the package locally to the machine you wish to install LanLicenser 4.1 to.

Step 2: Run LanLicenser4_1.exe and complete the extraction process. Once the extraction is complete, the LanLicenser 4.1 installer will be launched.

Note: If the LanLicenser 4.1 Installer is not automatically launched please run autorun.exe from the folder chosen during the extraction process

Step 3: Please refer to the 'LanLicenser 4.1 Evaluators Guide' (if doing an evaluation of LanLicenser) or the 'LanLicenser 4.1 Installation Guide' (if performing an installation to a live environment).

Upgrading From LanLicenser 4.0

Upgrading from LanLicenser 4.0 SP2 to LanLicenser 4.1 is fully supported.

Can I upgrade to LanLicenser 4.1?

In order to determine if you can upgrade to LanLicenser 4.1, you need to determine the build number of your current LanLicenser installation. To determine your specific build number:

- 1. Open the LanLicenser MMC Administration Program.
- 2. Right click on the 'ABC LanLicenser' node and select 'About LanLicenser...'
- 3. Make a note of the 'Version and Build number'

Only version '4,00,703' and above can upgraded to LanLicenser v4.1. If the version is lower than '4,00,703' then you must first apply Service Pack 2 (SP2) before upgrading. SP2 can be downloaded from <u>www.lanlicenser.com</u>.

Upgrading to LanLicenser 4.1

IMPORTANT NOTE: The original installation files used when LanLicenser 4.0 was first installed will be required for LanLicenser 4.1 to be installed correctly. If you do not have the original LanLicenser installation files available, please contact <u>support@lanlicenser.com</u>.

Step 1: Once you have downloaded LanLicenser 4.1, copy the package locally to the LanLicenser 4.0 Site Server machine.

Step 2: Run LanLicenser4_1.exe and complete the extraction process. Once the extraction is complete, the LanLicenser 4.1 installer will be launched.

Note: If the LanLicenser 4.1 installer is not automatically launched please run autorun.exe from the folder chosen during the extraction process

Step 3: Proceed through the LanLicenser 4.1 upgrade wizard.

Step 4: Once it is complete, click 'Finish'

Upgrading the Software Metering Server and Client(s).

The Software Metering Server (SWMS) and client agent(s) will normally upgrade automatically - there is no user involvement required during this process. By default, the SWMS should upgrade within 5 minutes and the client(s) within four hours. If you wish to check how long the client should take, please follow the steps below:

- 1. Open the LanLicenser MMC Administration Program.
- 2. Expand the 'Components' node
- 3. Right-click on the 'Clients' node and select 'Properties'
- 4. Select the 'Timings' tab.

The 'Check local environment every:' value is the one that will tell you how often the LanLicenser client will check to see if it is required to upgrade.

Please note: If you have previously manually installed any Software Metering Servers then the Site Server may not have sufficient privileges to upgrade them automatically. To upgrade your SWMS(s) manually, logon to your SWMS machine and run 'setup.exe' from the LicSvr folder located in the LanLicenser share on your upgraded Site Server machine and follow the InstallShield Wizard instructions.
